RE: Ohio's Home Sale Activity Report - May 2003

Home sales activity throughout Ohio continued at a strong pace in May, helping the market attain a year-to-date rate that nearly mirrors the record-breaking level of a year ago, reports the Ohio Association of REALTORS[®].

"The marketplace has been pleasantly strong during the first five months of the year - posting great numbers in May and putting us in a position for a possible record-breaking activity mark in 2003," said OAR President Bonnie Boyd. "Real estate has been, and continues to be, the true bright spot in an otherwise sluggish economic environment."

"With favorable interest rates and an excellent array of housing in most every price category...it's evident that Ohioans are sold on making the American Dream of homeownership a reality," Boyd added.

Statewide sales of new and existing homes (January through May) totaled 45,939, a negligible 0.7 percent decrease from the record 46,266 sales posted during the period in 2002.

The state's average sale price (January-May) of \$143,223 marks a 3.2 percent increase from the \$138,809 average posted during the period last year. The total dollar volume of \$6.6 billion is 2.5 percent ahead of the \$6.4 billion level posted during the five-month period in 2002.

Sales in May 2003 reached a record-breaking 12,287, a 3.3 percent increase from the previous best-ever 11,899 sales posted during the month last year. The month's average sales price of \$147,142 is 3.5 percent ahead of the May 2002 mark of \$142,192.

The 31,000-member Ohio Association of REALTORS[®], the largest professional trade organization in the state, calculates its home sale figures based on statistics provided by the Multiple Listing Services (MLS) throughout Ohio. Participating MLSes include: Ashland, Cincinnati, Columbus, Centralized Real Estate Information Services, Dayton, Firelands, Greater Portsmouth, Heartland, Knox, Lancaster, Licking, Mansfield, Marion, Northern Ohio Regional Multiple Listing Service, Scioto Valley, Toledo, West Central, Western Regional Information Systems & Technology and Zanesville. Figures include both new and existing home sales, including single-family and condominiums.
