RE: Ohio's Home Sale Activity Report - August 2005

Home sales activity throughout Ohio remains strong, with the market posting a record-breaking level through August, reports the Ohio Association of REALTORS®.

"The fact that the marketplace has been able to sustain a record-breaking sales pace during the first eight months of the year is ample proof that the American dream of homeownership is alive and well in the Buckeye State," said OAR President Jim West. "Housing continues to be a true bright spot in the overall economic picture."

Statewide sales of new and existing homes this year (January-August) total 98,874, a 5.2 percent increase from the previous best-ever of 93,969 sales posted during the period a year ago.

The state's average sale price of \$155,144 marks a 2.3 percent increase from the \$151,701 average price posted a year ago. The year-to-date dollar volume of \$15.3 billion through the first eight months of the year is 7.6 percent ahead of the \$14.2 billion mark posted in 2004.

Sales reached a record shattering 15,605, in August, a 9.0 percent increase from the prior best of 14,318 sales recorded during the month last year. The month's average sales price of \$164,735 is a 5.1% increase over the August 2004 average sales price of \$156,783.

The 35,000-member Ohio Association of REALTORS®, the largest professional trade organization in the state, calculates its home sale figures based on statistics provided by the Multiple Listing Services (MLS) throughout Ohio. Participating MLSes include: Ashland, Athens, Cincinnati, Columbus, Centralized Real Estate Information Services, Dayton, Firelands, Greater Portsmouth, Heartland, Knox, Lancaster, Licking, Mansfield, Marion, Northern Ohio Regional Multiple Listing Service, Scioto Valley, Toledo, West Central, Western Regional Information Systems & Technology and Zanesville. The report reflects reported closings by MLSes, including new and existing single-family homes and condominiums/co-ops.

{NOTE: There might be a slight variance between the reported number of sales contained in this release and actual activity in the various markets due to OAR's early reporting requirement. Check with contacts in the particular market.
