

Examining the Black-White Homeownership Gap

Homeownership is a key source of household wealth, most often representing our largest household asset. But a well-documented racial gap in the homeownership rate has limited the financial benefits that accrue to black households, contributing to a broader racial disparity in wealth accumulation. This program will review the key variables that have driven this homeownership gap and discuss policy recommendations aimed at reducing it.
